**blackbutt** (Eucalyptus Pilularis)

Is a blonde species commonly found along coastal plains and lower ranges in New South Wales and Southern Queensland. Marketed as Australian Beech in the United States, it is often used in beach houses in Australia for its light colouring and ability to handle heavy traffic.



**forest red gum** (Eucalyptus Tereticornis)

Is a slow growing gum typically found along the coastal ranges in New South Wales and Queensland. Red Gum is one of the few consistent dark red flooring timbers commercially available in Australia.



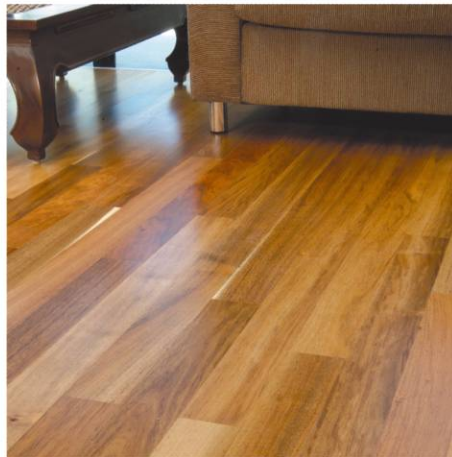
**recycled / reclaimed light hardwood**

Utilising Australian Hardwoods from all over the country – from disused wharves in Tasmania to old warehouses in Brisbane – nothing comes close to the look and feel of a genuine recycled/reclaimed hardwood floor in any application.



**brush box** (Lophostemon Confertus)

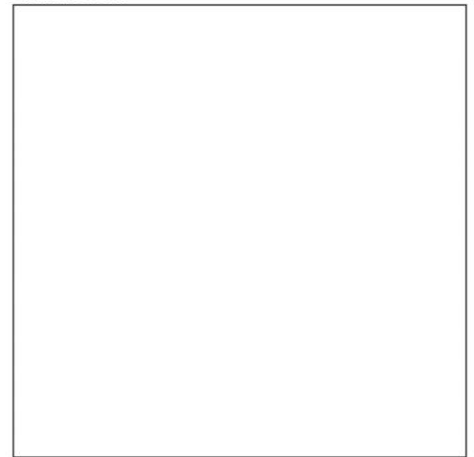
typically grows on the rainforest fringes from central New South Wales through to North Queensland, is the Rolls Royce of Australian timber floors. Rich browns with some occasional pink, red and dark browns typify this floor. Brush Box is typically free of gum vein or pin hole, is hard wearing and ideal for commercial or heavy traffic areas.



**tasmanian blackwood** (Acacia Melanoxylon)

Is a medium sized hardwood tree predominantly grown in the wet areas of Tasmania. Colloquially known as "Tassie Blackwood" this species has tones of golden brown often with narrow bands of darker colour. Reddish streaks can sometimes be present making this flooring beautiful in any area.
